5. While securing placement for children when there is no alternative identified to a night to night placement, what is your plan to further engage foster parents who want children picked up early and/or are not willing to assist with transportation?
6. What capacity in the current traditional licensed foster homes have been increased during Fiscal Year 2018 by Children's Home Network and the proposed subcontractors, and what would be the strategy moving forward for increasing capacity in current homes?
